## To receive hive equipment from the Individual Beekeeping Incentive Plan the following are required:

## A. Must complete all of the following:

- Complete 6 months of active membership, as a Junior member (Cloverbud time not included)
- Complete both 4- H Honey Bee Project Books
- Give an educational program for the club on Honey Bees or beekeeping per year
- <u>Participate</u> in 18 hours of a club Honey Bee/ Honey Promotional Projects (Ex: Strawberry Festival, Farmer's Market, etc.)
- Visit a Forager Apiary and participate in an Open Hive Demo
- Participate in a Skillathon Competition (or hold an executive office for a year and complete duties 90% of activities/meetings)
- Attend 2/3 of actual meetings
- Participate in 18 hours of Foragers' community service
- Purchase required equipment and pass the Tool Use Test

## B. Must Purchase and Present Required Equipment to include the following:

- Gloves
- Veil
- Suit or Jacket
- Feeder
- Hive Tool
- Brush
- Smoker

Upon Completion of A and B, within 2 consecutive 4-H years (October 1- September 30), the Forager will receive the following:

- 1. Outer Cover
- 2. Inner Cover
- 3. 2 Medium Hive Boxes
- 4. 16 Frames
- Screened Bottom Board
- 6. Entrance Reducer

Upon presenting a receipt of purchase of Bees or Bee products within 3 months of receiving a Forager's hive, the 4-H beekeeper will be reimbursed up to \$75.00, in the form of a check.
