What are the Foragers Achievement Levels?

Forager Achievement Levels are a means to recognize members with Certificates of Achievement for active participation. Members are encouraged, but not required to participate. The more members that participate, the better the results for our club. Our Charter Seal is a direct correlation to the participation of our members. Certificates are awarded for the degree of completion of a number of quality indicators related to:

1. Membership and participation
2. Citizenship and leadership
3. Life-skill development and subject matter instruction
4. Community involvement

How are Forager Club Certificate of Achievement Awarded?

For a member to be considered for a certificate, the member must submit a Certificate of Achievement application to the club leader. The application is due December 1. The member will complete the application with points they believed that they earned. Additional information can be added on the last page of the application or by attaching additional papers as needed. The leader will review their records of participation to determine if the members submitted score is accurate. The Foragers' Club Leader makes the final determination of the award level. Certificates of Achievement are presented at the clubs Awards Meeting.
